**Associate Degree Graduation Requirements:** (1) Complete all department requirements with a “C” or better in each course. Candidates for an Associate Degree are also required to complete at least 20% of the department requirements through SBCC. Pass/no Pass grading is not permitted in those courses needed to fulfill department requirements. (2) Complete at least 18 units of General Education Requirements ([Areas A-D](#) of the SBCC General Education pattern) OR complete the [IGETC pattern](#) (34-40 units) OR complete the [CSU GE Breadth pattern](#) (39 units); (3) Complete the SBCC Institutional Requirements ([Area E](#)); (4) Complete the Information Competency Requirement ([Area F](#)); (5) Complete a total of 60 degree-applicable units (SBCC courses numbered 100 and higher); (6) Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better in all college units attempted; and (7) Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better in all college units attempted; and (8) Candidates for an Associate Degree are required to complete 15 units through SBCC. (Note: Students who complete the 18 units of General Education option without fulfilling additional required coursework for the institution to which they are intending to transfer, will not be adequately prepared for transfer).

**Associate in Arts Degree in Liberal Studies:  
Emphasis in Education**

The Liberal Studies: Emphasis in Education degree at Santa Barbara City College (SBCC) is intended to prepare students to transfer to a Liberal Studies–Teaching Education bachelor’s degree program. Course requirements for Liberal Studies – Teaching Education programs are different at each four-year institution. Therefore, students pursuing this degree must select their courses in consultation with an SBCC academic counselor to ensure they satisfy the lower-division preparation for the Liberal Studies program of the four-year institution they are planning to attend.

The Liberal Studies: Emphasis in Education degree is an interdisciplinary program that provides students with a foundation of knowledge in the areas of English composition, critical thinking, oral communication, sciences, arts and humanities, and social sciences. Through this program students acquire a breadth of knowledge across multiple disciplines, explore how knowledge across disciplines can be connected, analyze and evaluate ideas using the tools of critical thinking, and demonstrate effective communication skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking.
