LIBR 101 — Information Literacy**(1) — CSU, UC****Skills Advisories: Eligibility for ENG 110 or 110H**Course Advisories: COMP 103 and 123**Hours: 18 lecture*

Information literacy is introduced and practiced: how information is created, disseminated and organized; and how to find, evaluate, think critically about and ethically use information. Students practice research skills, including narrowing topics; finding print, electronic and visual materials through the library and internet; summarizing and evaluating sources; and constructing citations. Satisfies SBCC Information Competency requirement. (*UC Transfer Limit: LIB 101 and ENG 120 combined: maximum credit, one course)
